Welcome to our virtual community for families of children with disabilities and caregivers. Joining the cyber-community implies the acceptance and compromise to follow these guidelines.

Here are the rules of use that all members must follow to ensure a safe and respectful environment:

1

RESPECT AND CONSIDERATION:

All members of the community should show respect and consideration towards others. Derogatory or discriminatory comments towards other users or their children with disabilities will not be allowed.

CONFIDENTIALITY

The privacy of each user and their personal information must be respected. Community members should not share other users' personal information without their prior consent.

APPROPRIATE TOPICS

Topics discussed in the community should relate to the challenges and needs of children with disabilities and their families. Users are expected to share useful information and emotional support.

NO ADVERTISING OR SPAM

The posting of promotional content or spam is not allowed in the community. Users who violate this rule will be banned.

5

MODERATORS

Community moderators reserve the right to remove any post that violates these usage guidelines. Users who repeatedly violate these rules will be banned.

ONLINE SAFETY

6

Users are expected to respect the laws and regulations applicable to online safety. Posts or actions that may jeopardize the safety of other users will not be allowed.

COLLABORATION

Community members should collaborate with each other, sharing experiences and resources that can help other members cope with their children's disability-related challenges.
