The arts-abled project is developing two main tools: the e-platform and the cybercommunity for families:

- **e-platform:** it contains activities on arts and employability to work with children with disabilities. You can upload and share your own activities and watch some videos about these activities.
- **Cybercommunity:** you'll have the chance as caregiver or family to interact with other caregivers and families from Turkey, Spain and/or Italy.

arts-abled is an Erasmus+ Project co-funded by the European Union, a Cooperation Partnership in the field of School Education (2021-1-ES01-KA220-SCH-00027905).



WHAT CAN YOU DO IN THE E-PLATFORM?

This platform was created in response to a problem in the classroom: the lack and dispersion of activities to work in the classroom with students with different types of disabilities.

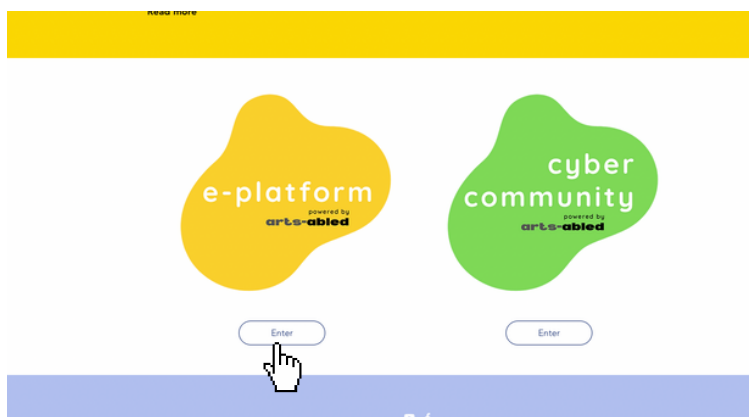
In this way, the partnership of this project has worked on the development of 16 practices that help teachers to work with students with disabilities through art, and another 16 focused on working on key competences focused on the employability of school education students.

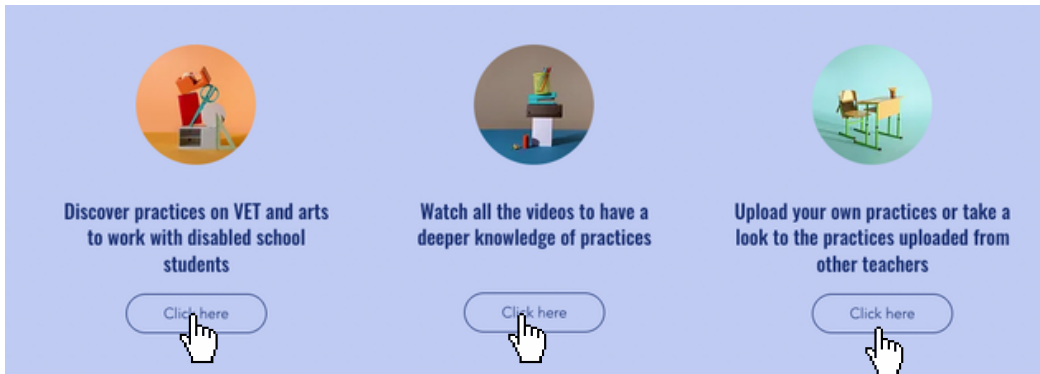
In brief:

- Upload your own practices or take a look to the practices uploaded from other teachers

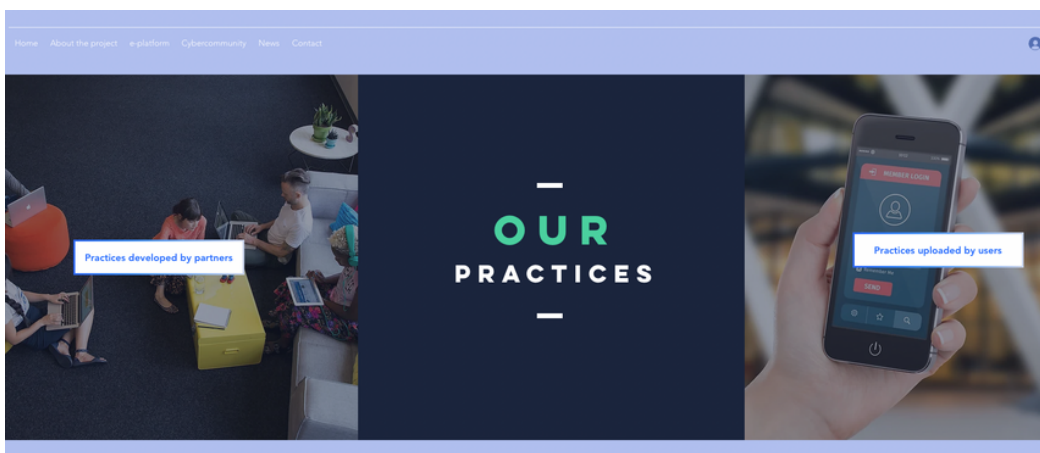
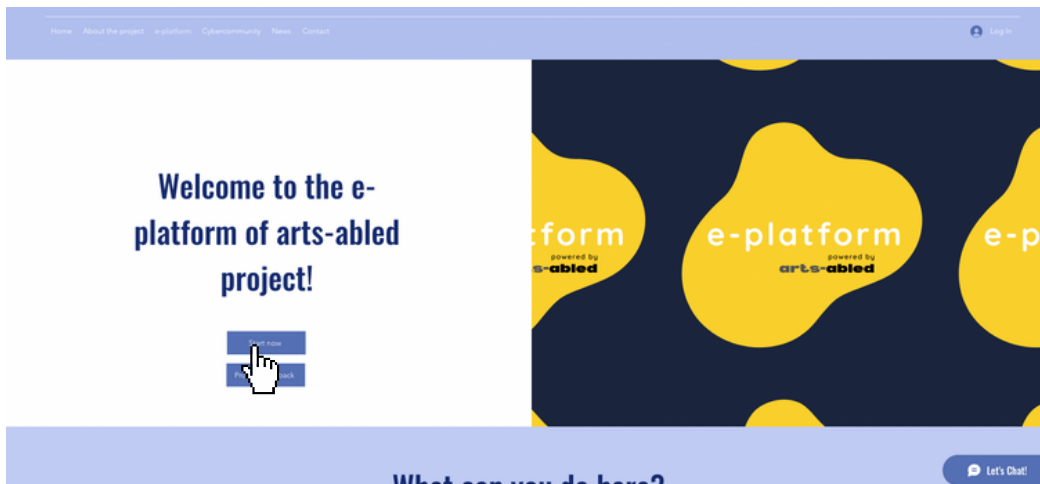

PRACTICES DEVELOPED BY PARTNERSHIP ON ARTS AND VET/EMPLOYABILITY

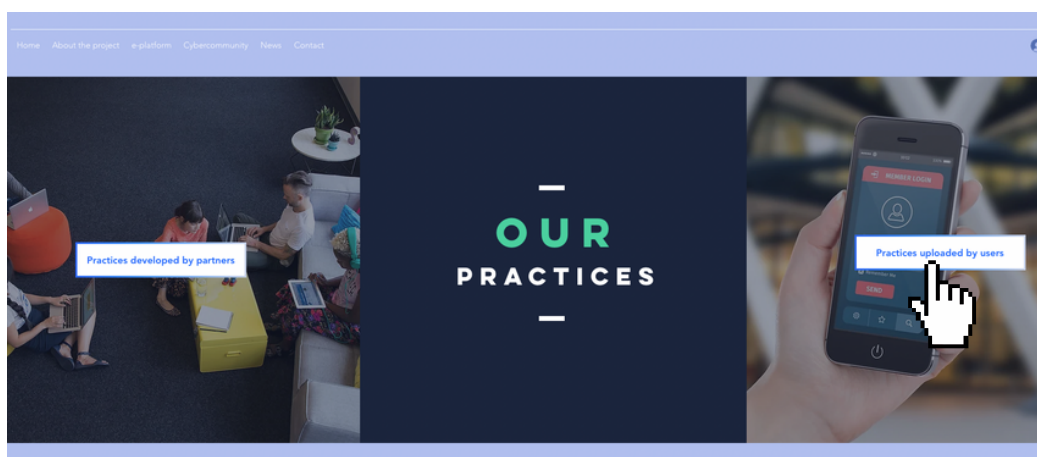

Follow the next steps and guidelines to upload your own practices:


